Health Certificate and Coggins Form

MUST be filled out by client or agent (trainer, manager, etc), prior to appointment of health certificate and Equine Infectious Anemia test (Coggins). Pictures will be taken at the time of the appointment if needed for coggins. Coggins test (EIA) should be done every 6-12 months depending on state or country traveling. Some states require coggins test 30 days prior to shipment.

We recommend a coggins and health certificate at least 10 days in advance to travel. Labs can take up to 48 hours, even with rushed testing.
